- To organize a workshop alongside with EGEEC meeting to address urbanisation concerns and energy efficiency technology development challenges as well as to share the best energy efficiency policies and practices, and the emerging new technologies.



Energy Intensity Reduction in the APEC Region's Urbanised Cities

Project Objectives

- To share the experience and best practices of the selected four (4) to five (5) urbanised cities on energy intensity reduction;
- To collaborate with international organisations, government, policy makers, academia, industry and other related stakeholders in order to build APEC member economies' capacity in developing modern energy efficiency policy frameworks;
- To formulate policy recommendations on energy intensity reduction.
