- The Terms of Reference for the EWG and its six subsidiary bodies, including EGEE&C ToR, were endorsed by SCE and submitted to Senior Officials on 18 November 2021 and were renewed on 26 November 2021.
- The renewed EGEE&C ToR was effective from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2025.

EGEE&C Contact List

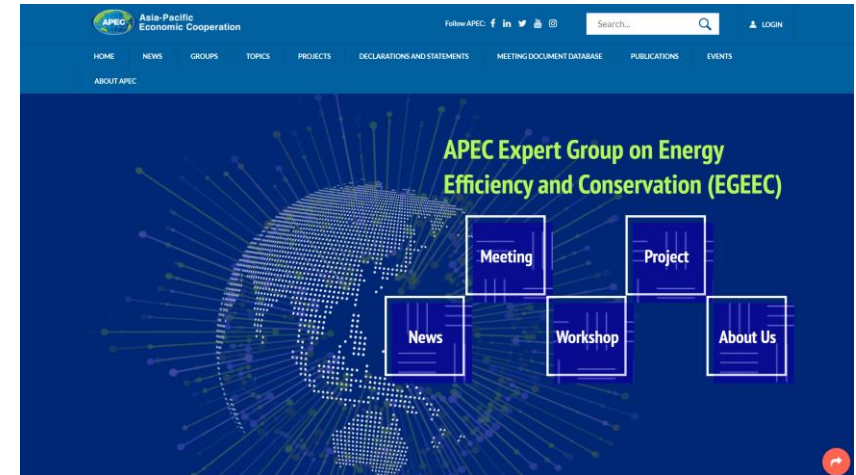
- The latest EGEE&C Contact List was updated and circulated to members on 10 March 2022.
