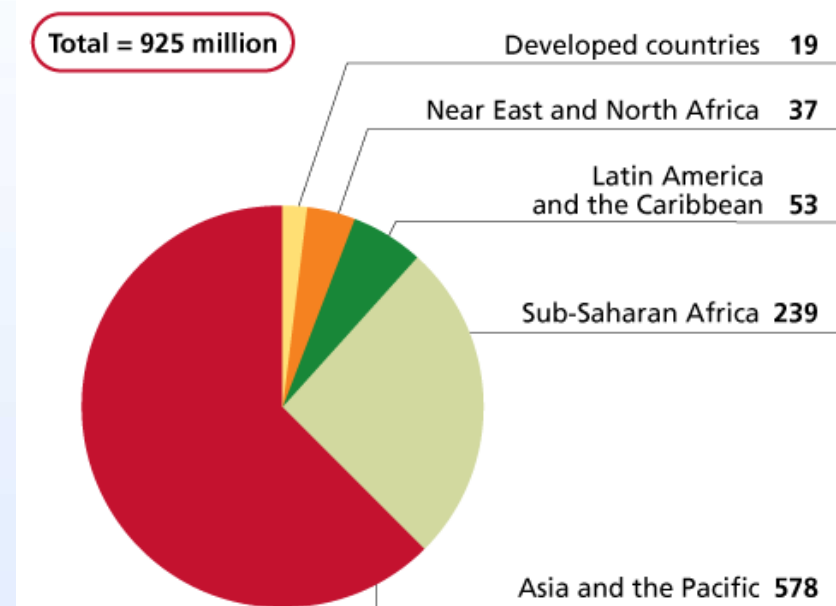
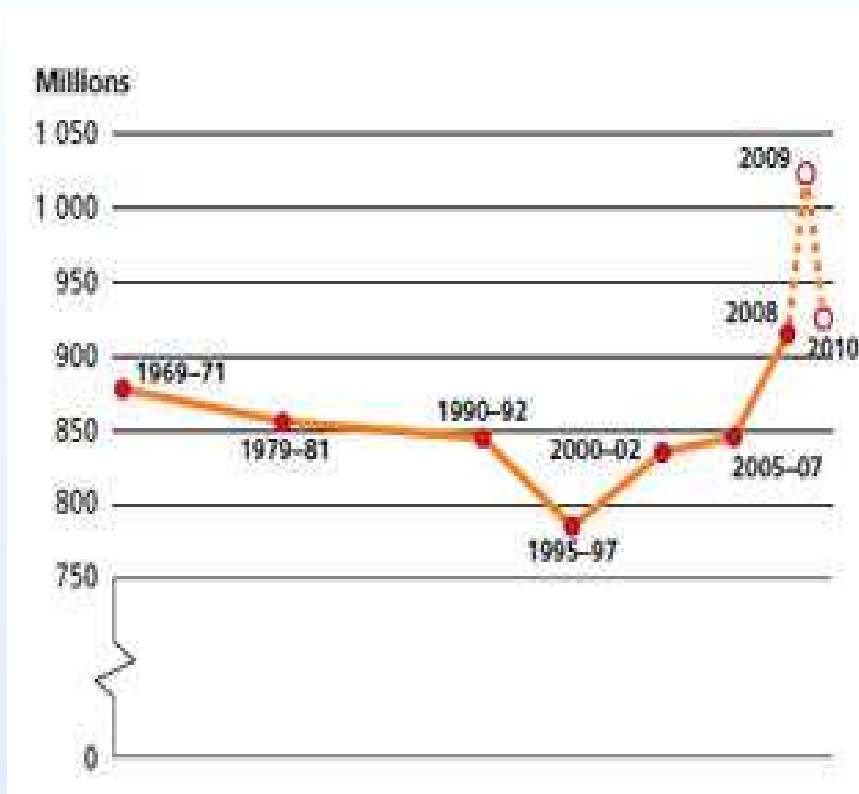

The following cross-cutting issues put forward:

- Increasing agricultural production and productivity;
- Facilitating trade and developing food markets;
- Enhancing food safety and quality;
- Improving access to food for vulnerable groups of population;
- Ensuring the sustainable management of marine ecosystems, and combating illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing and associated trade.

Kazan Declaration on Food Security, **30-31 May 2012**

- The most important conditions to achieve food security are sustainable increase of agricultural production and productivity in agriculture, especially through increased investment and active implementation of innovative technologies, and promotion of open trade and the development of food markets

Promoting Investment in Agriculture

Proposals:

- to establish realistic goals to support the increasing stream of private investment in agriculture;
- elaborate measures to attract targeted investments into food market infrastructure and areas of sustainable agriculture;
- PPFS to develop appropriate recommendations to improve the business climate in APEC economies, promote investment in agriculture economy and reduce unnecessary barriers to investment cooperation.

Improve the efficiency, transparency and predictability of the food markets

Proposals:

- to establish the monitoring of the food market and to exchange by reliable and timely information on the volume of production, consumption and trade and food supplies;
- the development of market-based instruments to reduce risks associated with volatility.

Food for vulnerable population groups

Proposals:

- to share best practices of food provision to vulnerable groups including social and school feeding, development of local agriculture;
- to consider a possibility of implementing projects on rendering humanitarian assistance in providing food to APEC economies in need or affected by natural disasters.

Infrastructure Development of Food Markets

Proposals:

- to attract targeted investment in infrastructure development of food markets;
- to develop a common understanding of the need to follow international standards for food safety, harmonization of approaches to assessment and risk analysis of food safety, development of uniform criteria in the inspection and certification bodies.
